Entry forms post-marked after April 16th will be charged DOUBLE entry fee (two copies of entry form is needed). Entry forms turned in at the fair committee meeting will not be charged the late fee.

Only 3 LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE FAIR AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE. NO LATE ENTRIES FOR SMALL OR LARGE LIVESTOCK.

(Auction Baked Goods/Non-baked Items will be accepted Friday or Saturday without late fee.)

CREATE AN ENTRY REFLECTING THE FAIR THEME

Be creative! Make a fair entry reflecting the fair theme – “4H Expanding your Horizons”

Open to all 4-H members, with no age classes.

Entry should relate to the fair theme in someway. Entries will be evaluated.

Enter as DIVISION 990, Class 1 – Fair Theme Entry.

ARCHERY COMPETITION – (see Fair Handbook, pg. 53)

The archery project member must submit a signed statement from their Archery Project Leader confirming that they are a certified Archery Project Leader in good standing and that the member has been trained in archery competition skills and procedures.

HORSE SHOW (Fair Handbook, pg. 33)

SMALL LIVESTOCK AREA

Small Livestock Division will be a **one day show** on Saturday at the Ernie Howlett Park.

FAIR ACTIVITIES

1. There will be activities on Saturday & Sunday at the Rancho Vista Elementary School. A more detailed list of activities will be announced on each specific day.
2. There will be no Opportunity Table activities at the SGV 4-H Fair due to a limited amount of space at the Rancho Vista Elementary School auditorium.

REMINDERS:

To help the SGV 4-H Fair in its setup, operation, judging, cleanup, etc., the following has been implemented this year:

--- If a club member/adult enters from the North San Gabriel or South San Gabriel districts, one adult and one youth are required from the club to help out at the SGV 4-H Fair.

--- If a club member/adult enters from the San Fernando Valley or Antelope Valley districts or any club in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties, one adult is required and one youth is recommended from the club to help out at the SGV 4-H Fair.

FLY SHEET (pg. 4) – 2020 SGV 4-H Fair Information

--- Each club that has entries at the SGV 4-H Fair should have a designated adult to pick up their club's entries at the end of the fair on Sunday. Any fair entries that are left at the end of the fair may be donated or thrown away.

--- Entry forms are required to have the member's, the parent/guardian's and the leader's signatures. Entry tags should be signed by the leader.

--- Look at the 2017 SGV 4-H Fair Handbook for the current information about your entry areas. There are a few changes of which you should be aware. This flysheet contains the latest information about the fair and should be read carefully.

--- All tabs at the Auction Table must be paid prior to the end of the day (Saturday) of the SGV 4-H Fair. The starting of tabs must be on the approval of the Auction Director. Tabs are not encouraged.

--- There will not be a concession booth. There will be an independent food truck.

--- No visiting near the fair entries during evaluating (judging). (Signs will be put up as well as the area roped off.)

--- Entry Release times - **No large or small livestock** will be released until all pens and cages are removed and the Areas are completely cleaned. Release time for large and small livestock is 2pm on Saturday. Release time for other exhibits –after Awards Program on Sunday, approximately 11 a.m. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
